

SJCDWQC Steering Committee Minutes – Monday, February 11, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Mike Wackman. The agenda was accepted and approved by consent.

Financial Report – Mike W. discussed the financial report.

Membership Report – Ruth reported that she and Wendy have been following up on A/R's. They have contacted every member who owes more than \$100.00. Several C.E. classes are scheduled for February.

Program Managers Report– (Please refer to the attached Program Managers Report) Melissa T. reported that a storm event sampling along with the regular sampling occurred last week. The January storm sampling results have not been received. The GW trend monitoring was completed in the Fall of 2018. Domestic well sampling begins in 2021 in our Coalition. ESJ began domestic well sampling in 2019, the RB is working out the glitches in how to enact the domestic well reporting. On 1/18/19 we submitted our Management Plan completion request. We eliminated several test sites, but still have six Management Plans to complete. Mike J. continues to work on a detailed critique of the Bio Stimulatory Process that he will submit to the WB. The annual survey packets were mailed in January and are due 4/1/19. To date we have received 7% of the NMP SR for 2018. In 2020 our Coalition will have new NMP worksheets, and in 2021 we will have new NMP SR forms. These new forms will include trans-evaporation rates, estimated amount of water used, types of scheduling to apply water, and the amount of N in your irrigation water. A Regional Board meeting on the expert panel being developed to review the surface water monitoring program occurred on at the end of January. The RB is putting together an expert panel to review the program with Southern California Coastal Water Research Project (SCCWRP) being the coordinating entity directing the panel. The Stakeholders have an advisory panel to devise questions to be directed to the potential expert candidates who will be appointed to the surface water monitoring panel. Mike W. and Melissa will report back to the Steering Committee on the progress of the expert panel.

Old Business – Mike W. reported that the CV Salts Program held an outreach workshop for the stakeholders. CV Salts is focusing their efforts in the South Valley. It will be approximate 5 years before the North Valley will have to participate in source control of a management zone.

New Business – None.

Public Comments – Spray Safe will be held 2/26/19. The SSJID has an opening for an executive secretary position.
